

#### AWARD NOMINATIONS

Fall Rallies are the perfect time to put your committees together to nominate your members for Lifetime Achievements and Camper of the Year. The nominees names, with all the information needed to qualify (per the COM Manual) send to National Coordinator. The deadline is January 30 of each year.

Chapters do you have someone that needs to be recognized for their worthy service in COM. These awards are the perfect opportunity to honor them. Read in the COM Manual the qualifications for each of these awards.



# POSSIBLE RECOMMENDATION TO CHANGE AWARDS PROGRAM

North Carolina President James Brown brought forward a recommendation

The recommendation is: There be one Lifetime Achievement Award; and one Camper of the Year Award at the National Rally.

National Coordinator reminded the presidents, they are the voice of you the members. Each president is to share the details with their membership over the next year.

Each state membership will vote their choice. The president will bring your vote to the Presidents Business Meeting at 2020 National Rally.

As it is now in our COM Manual, each state may submit as many Lifetime Achievement Awards

# (CONT) RECOMMENDATION

as they desire. Each state has one Camper of the Year Award.

If Recommendation is passed by your vote:

States will send in names of your nominees for Lifetime Achievement Award and Camper of the Year Award.

National Coordinator and Regional Representatives will review all nominees for each award.

Then we as a committee, choose 1 person out all nominees sent in to receive Lifetime Achievement Award.

(Example) 6 states send in a total of 16 nominees for Lifetime Achievement Award, only 1 person (nominee) will be selected for the award.

Camper of the Year Award, same as above, 1 person will receive this award.

(Example: 6 states send in 1 nominee each. We may choose 1 person (nominee) out of the 6 states.

Only 2 plaques will be awarded each year at the National Rally.

Deserving members that are nominated in your state may not get an award for sometime, (you will need to resubmit your nominees every year) as only one nominee a year will receive these 2 awards

You as a state are autonomous; you decide what you want as an individual chapter. This is for the members of each chapter to let your voice be heard in a vote at your Spring Rally or before.

Your president brings your decision/vote to the Presidents Business Meeting in 2020.

In the next Monthly News we will publish the minutes from the 2019 Business Meeting. We will remind states of this recommendation and what it means to you as the membership of National Campers on Mission.

Every month this will be published again.
